ECONOMIC OVERVIEW



Indian and Indonesia share 70 years of diplomatic relations. Indonesia is the 10th largest trading partner of India with total trade worth USD 19 Bn in 2019-20.



Indonesia's cumulative FDI in India is estimated at USD 600–700 million. Maharashtra likely received USD 180–220 million, focusing on infrastructure, manufacturing, and energy.



The two countries have signed MoUs for cooperation in defence, maritime, healthcare, science & technology, railways, pharmaceutical and more.



Top sectors of Indonesian investments are construction, oil & gas, food processing.



Some major Indonesian companies in India are Mitra Jaya Group, Salim Group, Garuda Foods, Bank International Indonesia, CP Prima and more.



India's outward FDI to Indonesia is estimated at USD 1–2 billion, with Maharashtra contributing USD 0.5–1 billion, primarily in infrastructure, steel, and pharmaceuticals.

Maharashtra is the biggest and the most attractive investment destination in India with robust policies, mature infrastructure and skilled manpower.

Estimated at USD 3.78 billion, assuming a similar 27% share.

Exports: Estimated at USD 2.26 billion, representing about 27% of India's exports to Indonesia.

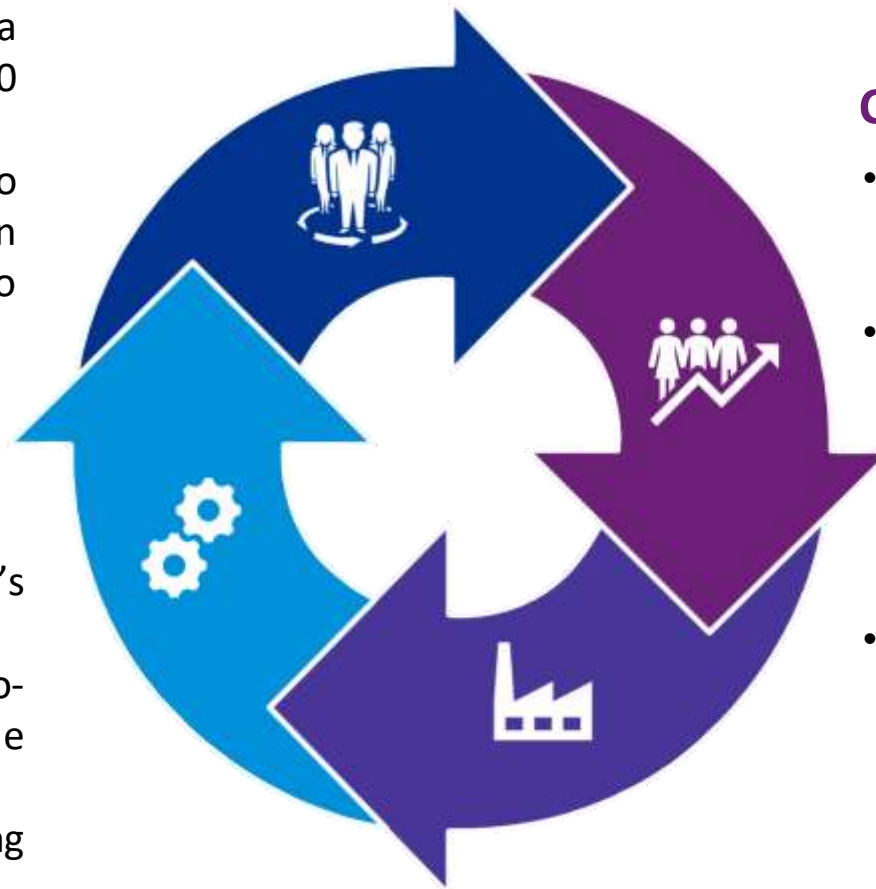
INDONESIA ECOSYSTEM MAHARASHTRA
