### **Economic Relations Overview**





Russia – India Trade stands at USD 65.7 billion in 2023-24.



India's exports worth USD 4.26 billion and imports from Russia amounting to USD 61.44 billion.



41% of the exports from India to Russia are consumer goods; 50% of the goods imported from Russia are intermediate goods.



About 300 registered Indian Companies operate in Russia.



Russia has established a Far East Agency in Mumbai to strengthen commercial relations.



There are 20 educational institutions across Russia that teach Indian languages.



**Strong International Partnerships:** BRICS, SCO (Shanghai Cooperation Organisation), NSG (Nuclear Suppliers Group), UNSC (United Nations Security Council)

Russia and Maharashtra have also strengthened their investment ties, with Indian companies investing in Russia's oil and gas, pharmaceuticals, and IT sectors, and Russian companies investing in India's energy, infrastructure, and manufacturing sectors.

#### **Ecosystem driving initiatives**

Operationalization of the 'Green Corridor' project between the two countries which has already reached an advanced stage

Implementation of the International North- South Transport

Corridor The signing of an FTA between Indian and the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU). In December 2016, Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) approved the decision to start negotiations between India and the EAEU for signing an FTA.

#### **India-Russia Joint Technology Assessment & Accelerated Commercialization Programme**

The Department of Science and Technology has launched India-Russia Joint Technology Assessment and Accelerated Commercialization Programme in partnership with the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) and Foundation for Assistance to Small Innovative Enterprises (FASIE) of the Russian Federation.

#### Maharashtra's engagement with Russia

#### **India Russia Cooperation in the Far East**

- In Aug 2019, the State of Maharashtra, Republic of India and Republic of Buryatia of the Russian signed Memorandum federation а Understanding to set up hotels / resorts to accommodate increasing tourist flow to visit Lake Baikal, this lake is the worlds deepest and largest freshwater lake by volume of 60% of the shoreline of Lake Baikal lies in the province.
  - Maharashtra State focused on state provinces such as Buryatia, Primorsky Krai, Magadan, Khabarovsk Krai for Signing of MoU's.

#### Intergovernmental commissions

- There are two key inter-governmental commissions between the two nations:
  - IRIGC-TEC Scientific. (Trade. Economic, Technological and Cultural Cooperation)
  - o IRIGC-MTC (Military Technical Cooperation)

#### A few recent Russian Investment in India/Maharashtra

Novolipstek Steel (NLMK) to invest INR 5000 Crore by 2022 in Aurangabad Industrial City (Auric) and generate around 2,000 jobs
